

MASON TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING

Regular Meeting

May 11, 2021

The meeting was called to order at 7:00pm with Supervisor Brandt leading in the pledge of allegiance.

Roll call answered by Trustee Allen, Trustee Arnold, Supervisor Brandt, Clerk Dull, and Treasurer Chew.

Supervisor Brandt welcomed the public and asked for public comments – no public comments.

Trustee Arnold made the motion to approve last month's minutes, with Treasurer Chew seconding the motion. Motion carried.

Trustee Arnold made the motion to approve the financial obligations, seconded by Trustee Allen. Roll call vote – yeas – Chew, Allen, Arnold, Dull and Brandt. Nays – none. Motion carried.

Inspector Wickey's ok before the rezoning can take place. He is checking on Harp's Corner. The parcel on Five Points Rd. he will need to contact the attorney. He will call CCRC about signs on the side of the road.

SEPSA – reported by Trustee Arnold. The Newburg contract was renewed. This will be an annual item. The new radio tower will be at the Fire Station, it is a combining St. Joe County and Cass County, paid for from Dispatch Authority. Mason Township had 30 calls last month. The time average was 7:57 for ambulance and 13:00 for fire trucks.

Chairperson Cloud reported the Master Planner Rebecca Harvey will be at the next month present the new Master Plan. Next meeting is May 18th, 6:30pm.
