

Mason Township Board Meeting  
Regular Meeting  
June 14, 2022

The meeting was called to order at 7:00pm with Supervisor Brandt leading in the pledge of allegiance.

Roll call was answered by Treasurer Chew, Trustee Arnold, Clerk Dull and Supervisor Brandt. Trustee Allen was ill.

Supervisor Brandt welcomed the audience and asked for public comments. No public comments.

Trustee Arnold made the motion to approve tonight's agenda, with Treasurer Chew seconding the motion. Motion carried.

Trustee Arnold made the motion to approve the consent agenda – May minutes, Treasurer's report and Payables for Approval of \$81,311.88. Roll call vote – Chew-yes, Arnold-yes, Dull-yes and Brandt-yes. Motion carried.

Reports: **Cass County Commissioners Marchetti** reported Jeff Carmen is leaving but his assistant Matt Newton will take over the position. The commissioners have purchased 2 watercrafts for the sheriff dept. There will be a Cleanup day for hazardous and electronics on August 27, 9am-noon. The new District Maps have been approved. Homelessness in Cass County project is being considered by the commissioners.

**Zoning administrator Krempec** reported he and the PC are working on the Jensen property. He will contact the township attorney on this matter. There seem to be a lot of fence disputes lately. This is a civil matter between neighbors.

**SEPSA** – Trustee Arnold reported the radio tower project will be done in October 2023. SEPSA is not in charge of this project, St. Joe County is.

Fire Chief Holderman would like to hold a class on CPR Training. He has ordered 400 kits to use for this project. He has not selected a date for the training.

**Sheriff Behnke** arrived and asked to speak. He reported the storm on Monday evening hit Marcellus very hard. Many trees down closing Marcellus Highway and other streets. There have been 4 fatal crashes in Cass County. Two on motorcycles, the other two were people crossing centerline of road. Pay attention when driving. No cell phones.

**Planning Commission** – Chairperson Cloud stated the June 21 meeting has been cancelled and the next meeting is attentively set for July 19<sup>th</sup>, 6:30pm.

**Building Dept.** – 2 building permits, 6 electrical permits, 1 mechanical permit, and 2 Plumbing permits.

**Unfinished business:**

1. Request from SEPSA - Trustee Arnold asked the board for the monies they allocated from the ARPA monies for SEPSA. Fire Chief Holdeman has found a used ambulance they would like to purchase. He will bring this back to the board next month.

**New Business:**

1. Trustee Arnold made the motion to accept the L4029 millage of 0.7826 for 2022. Seconded by Treasurer Chew. Roll call vote – Dull-yes, Chew-yes, Arnold-yes, and Brandt- yes. Motion carried.
2. The Park Committee request to purchased 2 new goals for soccer. Trustee Arnold made the motion for the committee to purchase 2 new goals for not more than \$4500. Soccer will make a great use of the grass at the township park. Roll call vote- Arnold-yes, Chew-yes, Dull-yes and Brandt-yes. Motion carried.
3. Supervisor Brandt will talk to Joe Bellina from the Cass County Road Commission concerning the speed limit signs at Juno Lake. What the cost to the township would be.
4. After a discussion on the need for a fax machine, it was determined the clerk would cancel the direct phone line used for the fax machine(no longer in use). All correspondence comes in email or post office.
5. Trustee Arnold made the motion, seconded by Clerk Dull, to approve resolution 06-14-22-01 changing the meeting date for the BOR to the third Monday in July and the second Money in December. Motion carried.
