Regular Board Meeting
August 9, 2022

The meeting was called to order at 7:00pm by Supervisor Brandt. Supervisor Brandt welcomed the public and lead in the pledge of allegiance.

Roll call was answered by Treasurer Chew, Trustee Allen, Clerk Dull and Supervisor Brandt. Trustee Arnold was absent.

Supervisor Brandt opened the meeting for public comments.
