### THE FOLLOWING RULES FOR THE CLEANUP WILL APPLY:

- 1) A driver's license or ID showing that you are a Mason Township Resident will be required.
- 2) Latex paint cans that are open & dry will be accepted, however the following hazardous materials will **NOT** be accepted: Toxic or hazardous paints, solvents, waste oil, gas, gas cans, propane tanks, closed barrels or drums, chemicals, pesticides or varnish. **(TO DISPOSE OF HAZARDOUS WASTE ITEMS, contact Cass County Road Commission)**
- 3) **NO** Computers, (desktop or laptop), Monitors (cathode ray or flat screens), Televisions (cathode ray or flat screens), Fax Machines, Printers, Video Display Devices (DVD, VCR, etc.)
- 4) **NO** Yard trimmings, leaves, grass, brush, rocks, sand, concrete rubble, bricks, and/or dirt.
- 5) **NO** Appliances including TVs, Refrigerators, Air Conditioners, or Dehumidifiers.
- 6) Other appliances **NOT** containing Freon, such as washers, dryers, stoves, dishwashers, water heaters, etc. will be accepted without charge as well as other misc. scrap metal, aluminum, copper, and brass.
- 7) **NO** tires
- 8) Car batteries will be accepted for a charge. (TBD)
- 9) A maximum of 3 vehicle loads per household permitted.
- 10) Donations will gladly be accepted to help offset the cost of the cleanup.
- 11) **ALL charges/fees will be payable by CASH OR CHECK ONLY.**
